

Data Protection and Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

Impact Fitness Academy CIC is committed to protecting your personal data and respecting your privacy. This policy explains how we collect, use, and safeguard your information in compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), Data Protection Act 2018, and other applicable privacy laws.

2. Data We Collect

We may collect the following categories of personal data:

- Personal Identifiable Information: Name, address, email, phone number, date of hirth
- **Health Information:** Relevant medical details (only when necessary, e.g., for program participation).
- **Demographic Data:** Gender, ethnicity (optional and only for monitoring inclusion).
- **User Activity Data:** When you interact with our website, we may collect IP addresses, cookies, or browsing data (see "Cookies" section).

3. How We Use Your Data

We use your personal data to:

- Deliver and improve our programs, activities, and events.
- Communicate with you, including updates on programs and events.
- Monitor and evaluate the impact of our services.
- Comply with safeguarding, legal, and regulatory requirements.
- Respond to queries or complaints.

4. Sharing Your Data

We do not sell or share your personal information with third parties for marketing purposes. However, we may share your data:

- With trusted service providers who assist in delivering our services (e.g., IT support, mailing services, delivery partners).
- Where required by law or to protect the rights of our participants, staff, or organisation.
